## Report on APPINTCON 2025: 7th International Pediatric Pathology Conference

Dates: August 22-24, 2025

Venue: Dr. TMA Pai Auditorium, 3rd Floor, KMC Manipal

Host: Department of Pathology, Kasturba Medical College (KMC), Manipal

## 1. Attendance & Participation

The conference, **APPINTCON 2025**, successfully drew a significant number of participants, both in-person and online. The total delegate count was **184**, comprising 141 delegates who attended offline and 43 who attended **online**. In addition, the event received **55 poster submissions**, with **8 shortlisted posters** presented during the conference.

#### 2. Conference Overview

The event spanned three days, with the first two dedicated to academic sessions and the final day featuring hands-on workshops. The conference maintained a high academic standard, with presentations from eminent national and international speakers covering a wide range of pediatric pathology topics. Notably, international speakers

**Dr. Srinivas Annavarapu Rao** from the UK and Dr. Sarangarajan Ranganathan from the USA joined the conference online.

### Day 1: Friday, August 22, 2025,

- The conference was inaugurated by **Dr. Sharath Rao**, Pro VC Health Sciences, MAHE, along with **Dr. Anil Bhat**, Dean, KMC Manipal, and Dr. Usha Kini, President, Association of Pediatric Pathology.
- Key presentations included Dr. Mary Mathew on "Minimally invasive tissue sampling in perinatal autopsy" and the
- VV Joshi Oration by Dr. Dinesh Rakheja on "Wilms Tumor: Tales of a Pathologist".
- A notable Panel Discussion on Bleeding Disorders facilitated a multidisciplinary approach to diagnostic challenges.

 Other topics covered included pediatric bone tumors, pulmonary neoplasms, and adrenal gland lesions in children. The day concluded with the Gala Dinner.

## Day 2: Saturday, August 23, 2025,

- The second day featured a keynote address by Dr. Nandita Kakkar on the accurate diagnosis of pediatric renal tumors.
- Dr. Jennifer Black continued her discussion on pediatric bone tumors, and
  Dr. Usha Kini presented a unique case on an "Appendix with a difference".
- Sessions also focused on pediatric myeloid neoplasms and rare pediatric enteropathies.
- The day emphasized community and collaboration, beginning with the Alumni Meet.

# 3. Hands-On Workshops

On the final day, three hands-on workshops provided practical training for a select group of delegates. The workshops and their attendance numbers were as follows:

- Placental Pathology: 27 delegates
  - Led by: Dr. G. Umamaheswari
- Hirschsprung Disease: 20 delegates
  - Led by: Dr. Usha Kini, Dr. Jayateerth Joshi, and Dr. Srinivas Annavarapu Rao (online)
- Inborn Errors of Immunity: 19 delegates
  - Led by: Dr. Mukesh Desai and Dr. Maya Gupta

It provided a valuable platform for knowledge exchange and professional collaboration, covering a vital spectrum of pediatric pathology from minimally invasive techniques to complex tumor types.
